

Pollutant	Source	Impact on health
Benzene	Paints, varnishes, lacquers, rubber or PVC flooring, detergents, tobacco smoke	Carcinogenic substance (Group 1)
Formaldehyde	Disinfectant cleaning products, resins and glues used in wood-based materials, permanent markers, fabric dyes, tobacco smoke	Carcinogenic substance (Group 1)
Particulates	Traffic, heating, industry, natural dust (pollen, windblown soil, etc.).	Effects on the cardiorespiratory system. PM10 stops at the upper airways, PM2.5 penetrates into the lungs.
Radon	Subsoil rocks on which the house rests	Carcinogenic substance (Group 1)
Trichlorethylene	Solvents, wood stains, adhesives, paint removers, fasteners, some cleaning agents.	Probably carcinogenic (Group 2B: sufficient evidence in animals, but not in humans)
Carbon Dioxide	Human breath	Beyond a certain concentration, attention, productive capacity, and general well-being decline.
